'sphery' which kirsty has created, produces an intrigue within the sculptural sphere's. 'sphery' produces shadows and movement. This allows the design to deviate from the functional to the non-functional.

'sphery' is the name of the collection, there are variety of versions, the work is currently one offs and limited edition pieces kirsty is more than happy to accommodate any commissions and variation.

'sphery' sits on the cusp between lighting and sculpture, 'sphery' 30 can be seen as multiples, or displayed individually for focused interest. the larger 50 cm birch sphery sits around a light bulb producing both clean-cut lighting and style. both are cut by laser, and then hand finished.
